The obvious question to ask those who do think some province is listened to more than it should be is "What province?" Today, as in 1948, Quebec heads the list.

Main reason given for thinking that Quebec has more to say in running Canada, today, is the belief that Quebec demands too much, and that Ottawa caters to its wishes more than it should. Those who named Ontario, referred most frequently to the accepted fact that it has the greatest economic power, and the largest population, and therefore its voice was more effective than other provinces.

In the West, the public pointed more to Quebec as carrying more than its due weight in international affairs. Those in Ontario were fairly well divided in naming either Quebec or their own province. In Quebec and the Maritimes, Ontario was selected as the most powerful.

Conviction that one province has more influence than it should is highest in the West (61%). In Ontario 38% say "yes"; in Quebec only 29%; while about half the people in the Maritimes agree.
