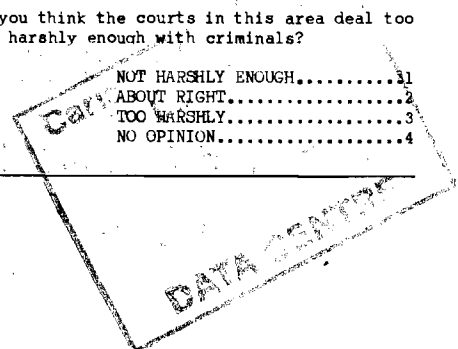

About a third of the voters cannot give a reason for their lack of approval for Mr. Trudeau.

To establish these attitudes about the man who is probably the most controversial Prime Minister Canada has had, Gallup interviewers asked:

"WHAT ONE THING, IF ANY, DO YOU DISLIKE MOST ABOUT PRIME MINISTER TRUDEAU?"

Here, in summary, are the reasons voters give for disliking Mr. Trudeau.

He shows a lack of dignity for a PM; give a poor image for Canada; too much of a playboy; acts like a teen-ager; kisses too many girls . . . . .	18%
He is not business-like enough; not organized; needs more experience; never gives a direct answer; evasive; vague; not a good politician. . . . .	16
He's too arrogant; flippant; reckless; cheeky; casual . . . . .	6
