An identical study in the U.S., reveals that Americans believe, as do Canadians, that the economy and unemployment are their most serious problems, but only 32% put them in first place, compared to 65% who do so in Canada. Vietnam is top concern for 17%, while the menace of drugs is at a much higher level there (13%) than in this country (5%). Other problems believed to be the most serious in the U.S., but named by less than one in ten, include racial difficulties, poor government, crime, bussing, poverty, hippies, foreign policy and the draft.

When the same question was put to citizens in the U.S. Gallup report that men and women there place a different emphasis on the most serious world problem although the order of mention was much the same as in Canada. Concern over Vietnam is high, raising the level of those who feel that world strife is the most serious to 61%. Less emphasis than in Canada is placed on the menace of famine and economic disparities, with 16% putting these in first place. However about the same proportion as in Canada, think that overpopulation or pollution is the main threat. Considerably more, proportionately, name such problems as lack of religion, immorality, drugs and communism.
