- 1 TOO LENIENT/EASY: just the way it's gotten too much sided with the criminal, there's too many bleeding hearts around, they have it too good, it is like home, not the way to run a prison like a wedding, prisoner has lost his rights by doing wrong, too many liberties, they make their own laws in jail.
- 2 LET OUT TOO SOON: murder you're out in a couple of years on good behaviour, if convicted up to recently you got 1/3 sentence off for showing up, for some crimes person let out on the street too soon, people are given reduced sentences, too easy to get out.
- 3 TOO MANY LUXURIES/CONVENIENCES/BENEFITS: because of all the facilities they have, they feed them too good, they should not have the luxuries of life like T.V., too many privileges, weekend leaves, some of the guys live in there better than outside world-they get 3 good meals a day and have T.V. and sports. I feel they are better off than poor people at the present time, they are better housed, clothed and fed than I am.
- 4 PUNISHMENT NOT RELATED TO SERIOUSNESS OF CRIME: they should be treated according to their crime, because people who commit crimes should be harshly punished, sentences are not enforced and people should be tried when crimes are committed, not enough division between serious and petty criminals.
- 5 REPEAT OFFENDERS RETURN TO SOCIETY: they commit so many crimes when they get out, dangerous people return to our streets, people on probation are also committing crimes.
