** DESIGN **

THESE DATA WERE COLLECTED THROUGH FACE-TO-FACE INTERVIEWS OF A MODIFIED PROBABILITY SAMPLE OF THE ADULT, NON-INSTITUTIONALIZED CANADIAN POPULATION, EXCLUDING LABRADOR, THE YUKON AND THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES.

** RECODES **

RECODING AND SPECIAL LABELLING WERE DONE AS FOLLOWS FOR THE INDICATED REASONS;

** OVERPUNCHES **

ON THE ORIGINAL PUNCH CARDS, RESPONSES WERE SOMETIMES CODED 'X' OR 'V' AND PUNCHED AS '+' OR '-'. THESE HAVE BEEN RECODED TO NUMERICAL '10' AND '11' RESPECTIVELY. BLANKS HAVE BEEN RECODED AS '99'.

** MISSING VALUES **

NO MISSING VALUES HAVE BEEN DECLARED. USERS SHOULD CONSIDER SO DECLARING "NOT STATED"S (USUALLY CODED '0' OR '99') AND "WILD" CODES.

** WILD CODES **

FOR SOME VARIABLES CODES APPEAR FOR WHICH NO LABELS EXIST, APPARENTLY PUNCHED IN ERROR. THESE HAVE BEEN LABELLED 'WILD CODES', BUT NOT RECODED.

** CONTINGENT CATEGORY MEANINGS **

SOME VARIABLES, THE MEANING OF THE CODES VARY, DEPENDING ON THE RESPONSE TO A PREVIOUS QUESTION. IN THESE CASES A SEPARATE NEW VARIABLE HAS BEEN CREATED FOR EACH POSSIBLE RESPONSE TO THE PREVIOUS QUESTION. FOR EXAMPLE, IF Q1A IS "DO YOU LIKE TAXES, YES OR NO?", AND Q1B IS "WHY (NOT)?", GALLUP HAS ASSIGNED ONE MEANING TO Q1B CODE '1' IF THE Q1A RESPONSE IS YES, AND ANOTHER MEANING IF IT IS NO. THE MARGINALS FOR Q1B IN THIS CASE WOULD BE MEANINGLESS. IN SUCH A CASE, WE WOULD HAVE CREATED Q1B1 AND Q1B2, CONTAINING THE Q1B CODES FOR Q1A YES AND NO RESPONDENTS RESPECTIVELY, AND DELETED THE ORIGINAL Q1B VARIABLE. THE "NO" RESPONDENTS WOULD RECEIVE THE "INAPPLICABLE" CODE ON Q1B1, AND THE "YES" RESPONDENTS WOULD RECEIVE IT ON Q1B2.

**** MULTIPLE PUNCHES ****

GALLUP USED MULTIPLE PUNCHES IN ONE CARD COLUMN WHERE MULTIPLE RESPONSES WERE LEGITIMATE, TYPICALLY "REASONS" FOR AN OPINION OR ACTION. THESE HAVE BEEN SPREAD OVER DUMMY VARIABLES (EG. Q1A#0, Q1A#1, Q1A#2...Q1A#10, Q1A#11), WITH A '1' IN THE DUMMY Q1A#X INDICATING REASON X WAS MENTIONED BY THE RESPONDENT, A '0' INDICATING REASON X WAS NOT MENTIONED. AN EXTRA DUMMY Q1A#12 IS SUPPLIED TO POSITIVELY IDENTIFY ORIGINAL BLANKS ("NO REASON MENTIONED"). ONLY THE DUMMIES ARE SAVED IN THE SPSS SYSTEM FILES.
