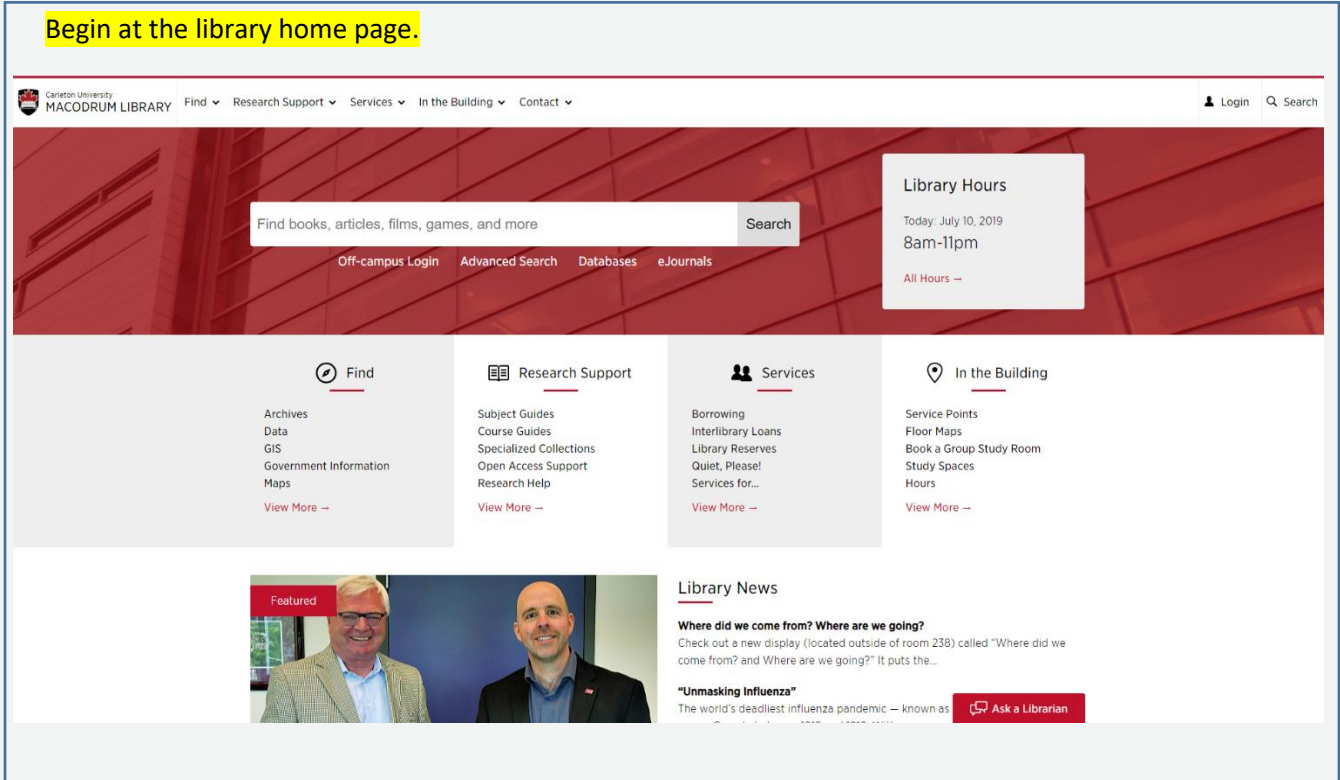




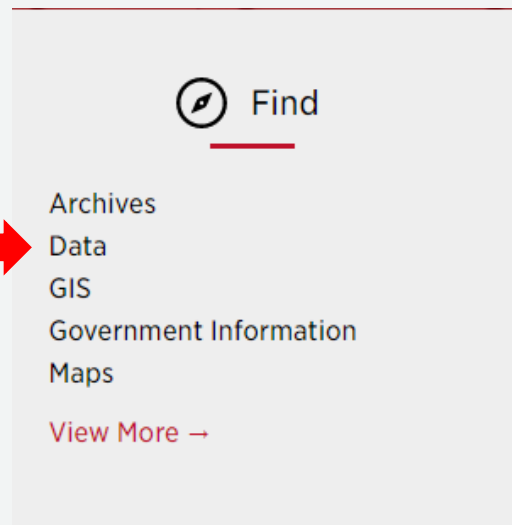
Navigating the Odesi Repository

This tutorial will show you how to navigate the Odesi repository.

Begin at the library home page.



Beneath the compass, click on **Data**.





Click the **<odesi>** website link.

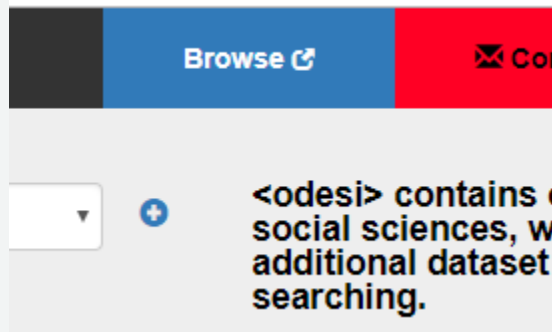
Need Canadian data? Start here if you're on campus

Below them are surveys in French.

To open and explore the categories, click on the category title or the plus sign beside it. Click on **Public Opinion Polls**.

If we click on **Demographic**, we will be given a list of all variables related to the respondent demographics.

Clicking on the variable, **Gender**, opens up additional information about that variable and shows a frequency chart of the two different genders in the survey.

Additionally, in the top right, you can choose to weight your data, subset your data, or download your data. We'll explore these options in another guide.
